Crazy About Curves Supply List:

Students are provided with a complimentary teaching pattern (choice of dancing star, tulip, abstract design or rose leaves).

<u>Sewing machine is required</u> (one capable of machine blindstitch ---^--^) Sewing machine foot—please bring an **open-toe applique foot** if you have one!

<u>Fabrics</u>--100% cotton fabrics. Batiks and multicolored hand-dyed fabrics. Bring a variety of favorite fabrics and include all colors in <u>at least</u> three values (light, medium and dark with a noticeable color contrast from a distance of approx.10 ft.) Choose colors that are vivid and bright, as well as some that are pastel (pale), shades (dark) tones (grayed) and the deepest dark colors. With this technique, you do not need fabric in large amounts— $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{1}{4}$ yards, scraps or fat quarters will do.

<u>Stabilizer</u>—one to two yards of Pellon regular lightweight or mid-weight stabilizer (*not iron-on or tear-away*)

<u>Freezer paper</u> 1-2 yards <u>Needles</u> (for sewing machine) use regular 80/12 for piecing <u>Scissors</u>- paper and fabric <u>Extension cord</u> (and an adapter for sewing machine, if necessary) <u>Steam iron and ironing mat or board</u> Check with your guild or program contact. Irons may be provided or limited in the workshop facility.

<u>Spray bottle</u> for water <u>Straight pins</u> (sharp!) <u>Threads</u> -bring a variety...for matching or blending the colors of flowers, leaves and background.

<u>Bobbin</u> wound with gray thread <u>Seam ripper</u> <u>Stitch Witchery</u> only if you have it already (comes on a roll, about 5/8" wide) <u>Batting</u> small amount (about 20" square) <u>Scotch tape, eraser, pencils, ruler, notebook</u> <u>Please, don't forget your nametags!</u>

Please remember, no workshop project is ever a masterpiece. This is a fun project. You are here to relax and learn an exciting new technique so please don't worry or agonize over fabric color choices.
